

Comments Sought on Fulton County 2009 American Recovery and

Union City and Fulton County are applying for funds under the 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program proposal. JAG helps governments thwart crime by funding local initiatives, technical assistance, training, personnel, equipment, supplies, contractual support, and information systems for criminal justice.

Union City is required by the U.S. Department of Justice-Office of Justice Programs to solicit citizen comments on the JAG proposed projects.
